HISTORY

In 1998, a small group of compassionate people with a big vision joined together and founded New Hope Clinic. That first year, we operated out of a single room and treated 38 patients. From this modest beginning, New Hope Clinic has come a long way. We now operate a 4,000 sq. ft. facility in Boiling Spring Lakes where we provide care five days per week, and limited services are offered through virtual visits and at a satellite location.

In addition to high quality primary medical care, we deliver a full range of healthcare services including specialty care, dental care, individualized patient education, and prescription medications. We also partner with other organizations to provide additional services and health education.

A small staff and over 100 volunteers, including doctors, dentists, NPs, PAs, pharmacists, nurses, medical & dental assistants, and administrative support personnel, contribute 8,000 volunteer hours to provide over 5,000 patient encounters annually. We help nearly 500 patients each year, but the need is even greater. FACILITIES

- Our main 4,000 sq. ft. clinic is located in Boiling Spring Lakes. Our satellite location shares a building with the CRCI in Shallotte. We also have applications and a secure drobox for returning them at the Lord's Pantry in Shallotte.
- The main clinic is equipped with all the essentials to provide patient care. We have intake rooms, exam rooms, a dental lab, dental examination rooms, a classroom, and a pharmacy. The satellite clinic is open parttime for enrollments and limited services.
